

East Hanover Township is now accepting grant applications for the 2010 Casino Gaming funds Distribution.

**Facts to know before you apply:**

1. Grants must be sponsored by East Hanover Township to be eligible.
2. Grants must meet the guidelines for eligibility as described in Act 71. Please refer to the attached link for complete eligibility guidelines.

3. The Board of Supervisors will only sponsor Grants for use predominately within the Township.
4. Any Grant sponsored by East Hanover is counted against the \$3,000,000.00 preferred funds per the MOU with Dauphin County.
5. The Board of Supervisors will assign any sponsored Grant a priority value within the list of Grants submitted by the Township.
6. The Board of Supervisors will look favorably on projects that include additional source(s) of funding.
7. The Board of Supervisors will not support projects that do not have definitive timelines, project costs and complete funding detail.
8. Final Grant submissions are to use only the Grant Template that will be on the East Hanover Township Website.
9. Applicants may request the Board of Supervisors assistance in preparing and editing Grants, but it is at the Board's discretion to make the consultant available and the cost for his/her time.

**IMPORTANT DATES – ALL DEADLINES ARE FINAL**

**May 19 – June 30, 2010**

All parties interested in applying for a Grant must submit a one page grant description.

**July 6, 2010**

Board of Supervisors will announce those applications selected for further consideration.

**July 27, 2010**

Complete Draft of application is due in the Township offices.

**August 3, 2010**

Applicants to make presentation to the Board of Supervisors.

**August 17, 2010**

Board of Supervisors will announce Grants to be sponsored.

**September 1, 2010**

Grants are due at the County.
