

**EAST HANOVER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
SPECIAL MEETING
8848 Jonestown Road, Grantville, PA 17028
July 30, 2007**

The Special Meeting of the East Hanover Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Marie Beaudet at 7:00 P.M. Present were Supervisors Keith Espenshade, Dave Marshall, and George Rish. Supervisor Tom Shutt was absent.

Deborah Casey, Secretary-Treasurer was also present.

Chairman Beaudet noted that the Special Meeting was called to grant permission for the Fire Police to be used at the request of the State Police for the opening of the Farmers Market on August 3rd.

- Mr. Marshall commented that in the past when a request was made to use the Fire Police for the private sector, there was always some sort of donation that was encouraged to be given to the Fire Police to help support the organization. It was not known if a donation will be made.
- Mr. Espenshade noted that the request was made by the State Police. The owner of the property is not making the request.
- Discussion was held on the issue and the property owner possibly hiring a rental agency to direct the traffic. Mr. Espenshade noted that a rental agency does not have the authority that the Fire Police has. Discussion continued and it was questioned as to why the State Police made the request and not the property owner.
- Mr. Marshall noted that in the future, when events are held by a business, the request should be made by the property owner and a donation should be made to the Fire Police since it is a volunteer organization.
- **Mr. Espenshade made a motion to allow the Fire Police to control the traffic at the event. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion. The motion was approved 4 in favor, 0 opposed.**

Mr. Rish made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 7:07 P.M.
